# Woodcrest Farm

## [Self-guided] Walking Tour

- 1 FARM STORE If you are on our CSA, each week you'll pick up your bag of produce here.
- 2 RABBITS CAUTION: Keep fingers out of the cages! Rabbits can bite small fingers.
- 3 FORGE Meet Allan, jack of all trades, and co-owner of Woodcrest Farm.
- 4 MAIN BARN Center Hub of the farm, home to 4 barn cats.
- 5 WOODWORKING DEMO If you wait long enough, he might let you have a hand at this craft.
- 6 ANTIQUE WAGONS Peak around the side of the barn and up in the loft to view some antiques.
- 7 STALLS Goat kids love to play, be sure to wash your hands and shut the gate when you leave.
- 8 BORDER COLLIES Our dogs are rarely kenneled and have probably introduced themselves already.
- 9 GREENHOUSE This is where plants begin. They then go out into the garden or hoop house.
- 10 HOOP HOUSE We can get plants in the ground as early as February 15th.
- 11 MILKING PARLOR If you are visiting at 8:00AM or 6:00PM, stop in to see where milk comes from.
- 12 DAIRY GOATS You may see a few Alpine dairy goats lazing around on a sunny day, or hiding in the barn.
- 13 SOIL BANK It ain't pretty but this mound of dirt is some of the richest, most organically fertilized soil.
- 14 MARKET GARDEN This is one of two garden areas in addition to the hoop house. Ask us about our CSA.
- 15 CHICKENS AND TURKEYS It's not hard to spot a chicken or turkey on this farm, they freely roam all 13 acres.
- 16 SOLAR ARRAY Take a look behind you to see our solar panels on top of the barn roof.
- 17 HOGS Take a side trip to visit our hogs in their Taiwanese style pig pen.
- 18 DEXTER CATTLE Look closely in this pasture, you may find a calf or two. Also, say hello to our bull Ranger.
- 19 POND AND WOODS TRAIL Enjoy a jaunt around the pond and into "goat land". Be sure to close the gate behind you.
- 20 DUCKS, GEESE, HERONS and many other critters who make this pond their home can be spotted if you're lucky...and quiet.
- 21 YURT This nomadic home houses our intern and her husband and their playful Pyreneese puppy.
- 22 PYRENEES Who guards the flock when we go to bed? Oak, the big white Livestock Guardian.
- 23 JERSEY DAIRY COWS Our 6 dairy cows are all friendly, each one knows their name, (and yes, cows can have horns.)
- 24 END OF TOUR Make your way back towards the barn to check out what we have for sale. If you have any questions look for someone wearing a bright green t-shirt.
